BIOGRAPHIES

Ruiya Zhong is currently pursuing a master's degree at Cleveland Institute of Music under the guidance of Daniel Shapiro. Recent awards include Grand Prize and Best Solo Performance at the Arizona Integrated Music Competition and 2nd Prize at the 2023 Walled City International Competition.

Maxwell Fetters is an incoming junior at Lehigh Valley Charter High School for the Arts in Bethlehem, PA. He studies piano with Dr. Daniel Immel of Kutztown University.

Qiaochuhan Li began her piano studies at age of four and is currently pursuing Bachelor's degrees in Piano Performance, Global Studies, and East Asian Studies at Lawrence University. An avid chamber musician, her recent performance highlights include George Crumb's *Vox Balaenae* and Antonín Dvořák's Piano Quintet, Op. 81. Beyond her work as a performer, Qiaochuhan is engaged in academic research exploring the concept of Oriental fantasy in Puccini's *Madame Butterfly*.

Olena Blahulyak is a Ukrainian pianist currently based in Houston, TX. She earned her DMA in piano performance from the University of Houston in 2024. In addition to her performance career, she is the founder and artistic director of a concert series in Houston. Olena began playing the piano at four, with her mother as her first piano teacher. She later pursued formal musical training at Lysenko's Special Music School and continued at the Tchaikovsky Conservatory in Kyiv.
