Can anyone apply to partake in the master classes and the summer session?

When may I apply for admission?

From December 1st each year for the following year.

How can I apply for admission?

Application forms are available on the Adamant website. Return to the **ADMISSIONS TAB** at the top of the window and select the **PROGRAMS** tab from the drop down menu. All the instructions are clearly marked on the application form. For further assistance, please feel free to contact the admissions office.

Is there an application fee?

No.

What does it cost to partake in the master classes and the summer session?

Menahem Pressler is \$1,100 for performers; \$1,000 for auditors. All the other Master classes are \$1,000 for performers; \$900 for auditors

The Traditional 3 week session is \$3,000.

How will I know if I am accepted?

You will be notified by email as soon as possible.

Do the fees for the summer session include my boarding and meals?

Yes and it includes a practice studio.

Beyond the cost of the program, are there any additional expenses I need to consider?

I have been accepted into the program, but I can't afford the fees.

There is financial assistance for the 3 week Traditional session only that one can apply for. Return to the **PROGRAMS** tab and select the **FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE** button.

What if I decide not to attend anymore and I have already paid my fees?

A non-refundable deposit is required to hold your place. If once all fees have been paid you need to withdraw from the program you may write a letter of motivation and the executive committee will review and decide accordingly.
